

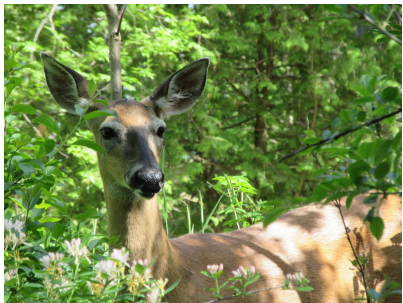
## White-Tailed Deer Hunting

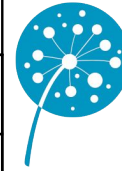
