Mass Murder of a Family

Kezzie Childs (42), Raymond Childs (42), Elijah Childs (18), Rita Childs (13), and Kiara Hawkins (19), and an unborn child of Hawkins were killed in a mass shooting inside a home in the 3500 block of Adams Street early Sunday morning, a report said. A juvenile male was also found injured in what inspectors believe was a targeted attack at those people carried out by multiple shooters at 4 AM, the Indianapolis Star reported.

“This morning, one or more individuals perpetrated an act of crime in our city,” Mayor of Indianapolis Joe Hogsett said at a press briefing later Sunday. “What happened this morning was not a simple act of gun violence... what happened this morning was a mass murder,” he said. Chief of the Indianapolis Metro Police Department Randal Taylor said the violence was their “largest mass casualty shooting” in over a decade.

Law enforcement are investigating whether the suspects illegally obtained the guns or not; they will also be looking into who was responsible for providing those guns, Mayor Joe Hogsett said during a public address from Indianapolis Metropolitan Police Department’s North District headquarters in the wake of the shooting.

Update: A juvenile was arrested in the killings and the police say they do not think any other additional shooters were involved. No other information was immediately revealed due to the suspect’s age.

Why don't scientists trust atoms?

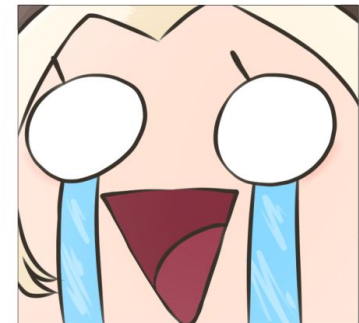
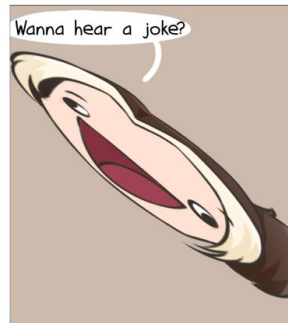
Because they make up everything!

Hydroponics and Gardening
