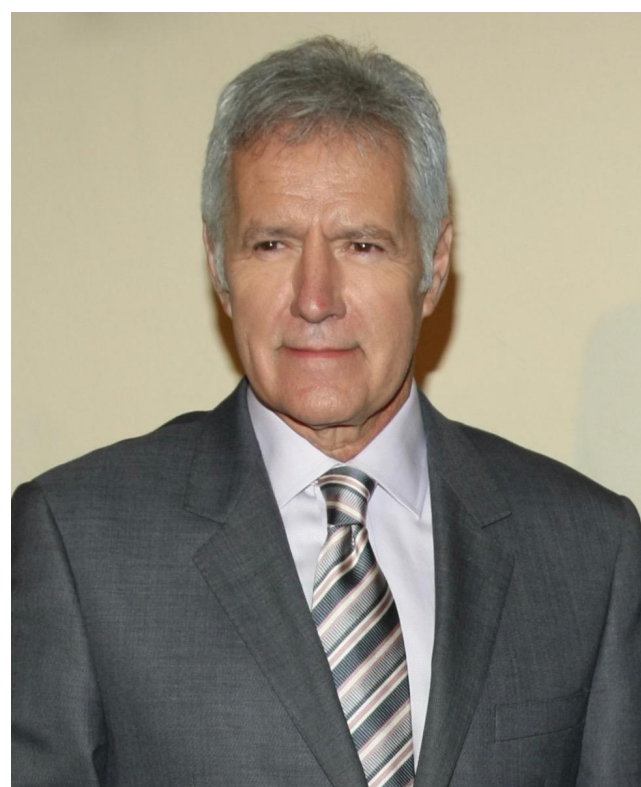


Alex Trebek's Passing

New Possible COVID-19

Vaccine

The US drug company Pfizer announced on Monday that the COVID-19 vaccine they've been developing is 90% effective on people who do not have the virus.

The company has conducted human trials on 43,500 people in six countries, with no safety concerns raised. They plan to apply for emergency approval from the FDA by the end of the month to use the vaccine.

Pfizer expects the final data by the third week in November, when they'll be able to apply for emergency use authorization. If it gets approved, the vaccine would be given to people in two shots.

Masks: Effective Way to Stop the Flow of COVID-19



Masks have a huge effect on the coronavirus. Wearing masks can help prevent the spread of COVID to others. Why? Well, read to find out.

According to the CDC's studies, masks are one of the most powerful "weapons" we have to fight COVID. Two hairstylists in Missouri who had the virus prevented the spread to their customers by wearing masks, and the wearing of masks in a Boston hospital system reduced the spread of the virus.

None of these **139** clients that the hairstylists came in contact with were ill, and the 67 clients that wanted to be tested were tested negative. Can you believe that?

Looking at the results of the UCSF (University of California San Francisco) experiment, it showed that hundreds of droplets that come out of single phrase when talking can be blocked simply by putting a damp washcloth over the mouth. Another study was done showing the COVID-19 growth rates before and after masks were mandatory in 15 states. It showed that **5 days** after the mask mandates, the growth rate had slowed by 0.9 %. **3 weeks** later, the growth rate had slowed by 2%.

Do you see now that wearing masks is such a big thing? It can be a great impact in the spread of the virus. The CDC is correct about masks being our most powerful "weapon" against COVID. Together, we can slowly but surely stop the spread of the virus.
